Slam on his brakes.

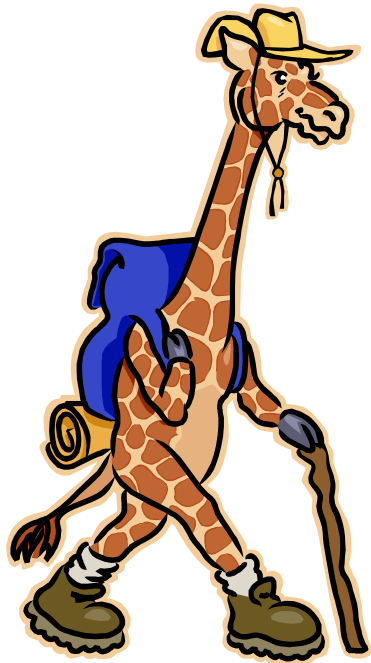
Wind down his window.

Slammed on his brakes.

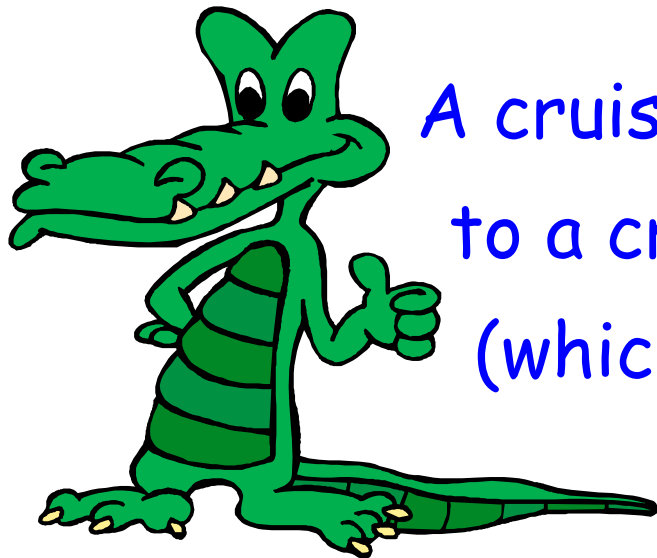
Wound down his window.
