

The name Enticott:

Endicott is the original spelling of the family name which can be traced back to Devon, England. It is believed that the name itself was derived from "Dweller at the End of the Cottages". There were several other spellings of the name with the most popular being Endacott and Endecott.

During the 17th and 18th centuries given the general level of illiteracy with names generally passed by word of mouth there would have been numerous cases in parishes of surnames being mis-spelt and Endicott is no exception. It is not difficult to imagine the name Endicott being spoken to a vicar or verger at a baptism, marriage or burial being interpreted as Enticott.

So there you go, Enticott's are "Mis-spelt Dwellers at the End of the Cottages"
